Bachelor's degree in any discipline from the University of Delhi or any other University recognised as an equivalent thereto, with at least 50% marks in aggregate. For candidates belonging to SC/ST/PWD/OBC/CW, relaxation in eligibility would be as per University rules.

IIMs have no role either in the selection process or in the conduct of the programme.

The candidate should follow the CAT advertisement of IIMs for procurement of CAT 2013 voucher.

Admission process:

The admission to MIB/MHROD courses will be made on the basis of CAT percentile, GD score, and Interview score. Students will have to submit CAT percentile after appearing in the Common Admission Test conducted by IIMs. The candidate has to apply separately for CAT 2013 to IIMs and for GD & Interview to the Department.
